Bobby Dixon, Sr., 77, of Chattanooga, passed away Sunday, October 4, 2020 at his residence. He was the eldest son of the late K.C. and Cedella Dixon Sr. He was baptized at Greater Beulah Baptist Church. Bobby was a 1961 Howard High School graduate. He was a veteran of the United States Army. He was employed by TVA in 1977 as a Health Physics Technician, where he later retired. He was a member of Antioch Primitive Baptist Church where he served on the deacon board. Bobby was preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Jimmy Dixon, Dorsey Dixon, Thaddeus Dixon, Marshall Dixon, and Tommy Dixon; and sister, Bobbie Jean Beasley. Survivors include his former wives, Clara Dixon and Nancy Dixon; five children, Nikki Ellis, Bobby Dixon Jr., Marcea (Melvin) Black, Samuel (Leslie) Dixon, and Satterra (Aaron) Grissom; four siblings, Travis Dixon, K.C. 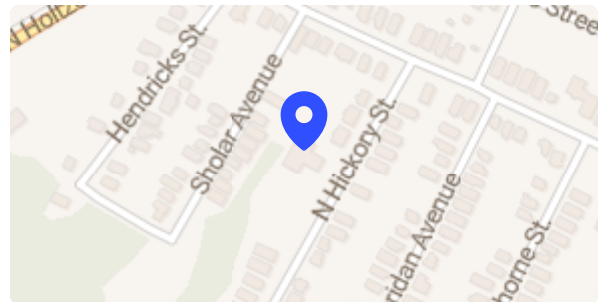

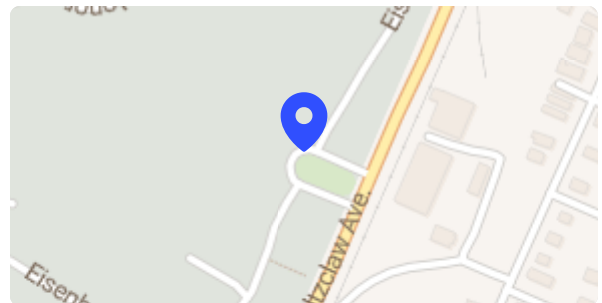

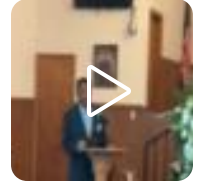
