Namon "Reco" Derring, Jr., 76, of Chattanooga, passed away Monday, May 10, 2021 at his residence. He attended Central High School and later became a veteran of the United States Army. He was former employee with Cutters Laboratory. Namon accepted Christ as his personal Savior in 1978 and was a member of Second Missionary Baptist Church where he served on the Deacon Board, Chairman of the Athletic Ministry and Pastor's Appreciation Committee, and Bus Ministry. Reco was a basketball official for TSSAA Basketball Officer since 1978, Member of ASA Softball Companion, and Krystal Breakfast Group. He was named 1999 Man of the year at Second Missionary Baptist Church. He founded Derring Janitorial Services, LLC. 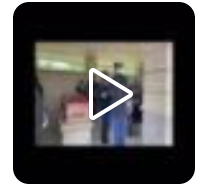
