Elbert Lamar Hinton, 82, of Chattanooga, passed away Wednesday, October 13, 2021, in a local hospital. He was the Valedictorian of his 1957 class of Hill High School in Lafayette, Georgia. He went on to attend Tennessee State University. Elbert was a member of Mt. Cavalry Baptist Church where he served on the Trustee Committee. He retired from Dupont in 1998 after 34 years of service. Elbert was preceded in death by his wife of 53 years, Beulah C. Hinton; grandparents, Henry and Bertha Hinton, Thomas and Felt Davis; parents, Chester and Vera Hinton; sister, Kathleen Neal.
