will shine forever more. Reverend Judge John W. McClarty is the officiant and Reverend Dr. Charles W. Sanderfur is the eulogist.



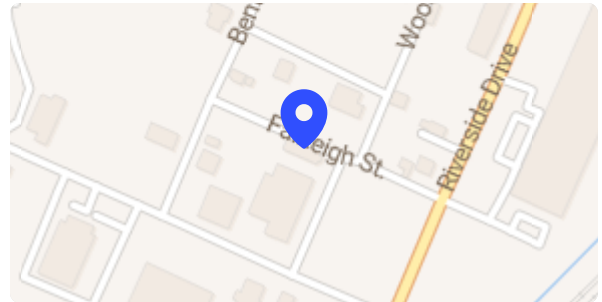

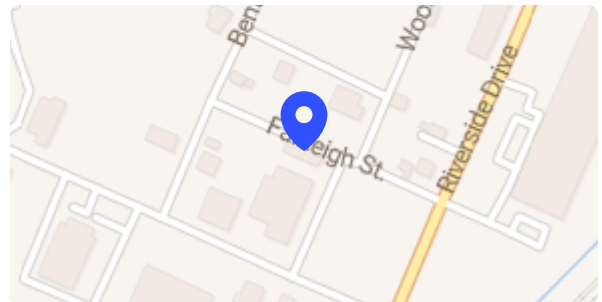

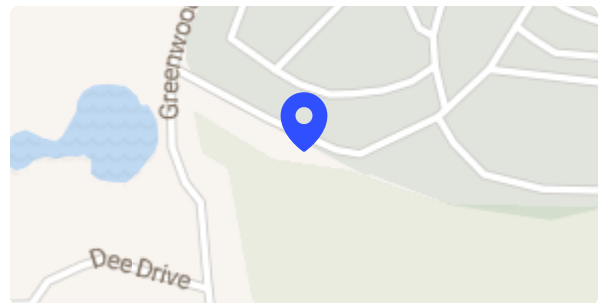
