Jacqueline Asberry, 81, of Chattanooga, passed away Monday, January 23, 2023, in a local healthcare facility. She was born January 1, 1942, in Chattanooga, Tennessee to Hazel Riley and Walter Kimbrough. She was a 1960 graduate of Howard High School. After high school, she attended Tuskegee University. Jacqueline was employed by Erlanger Hospital as a Unit Clerk/Secretary and retired after many years of service. She also was a School Patrol Guard. Jacqueline was formerly a member of Beulah Baptist Church and then later transitioned to New Covenant Fellowship Church. She was preceded in death by her mother, Hazel Kinamore; father, Walter Kimbrough; sister, Twilight Kinamore; brother, Harold Dudley; and stepfather, Albert Kinamore. 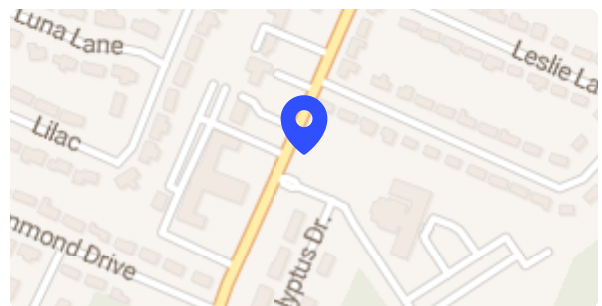

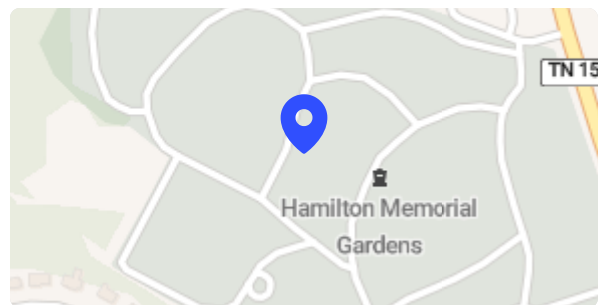

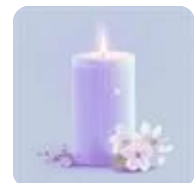
