Elder Ferrell North, 80, of Chattanooga, transitioned on Thursday, May 4, 2023, at his residence surrounded by his family. He was born in Carrolton, Georgia on April 18, 1943. At an early age his mother moved to Rome, Georgia where he attended Main High School. Elder North had a loving and caring spirit who enjoyed talking and praying for people. He also was a family man who loved his wife and children. For many years he worked for the city of Rome Georgia in Public Works until his retirement. He later went on to work for Chattanooga State Community College in the Maintenance Department. 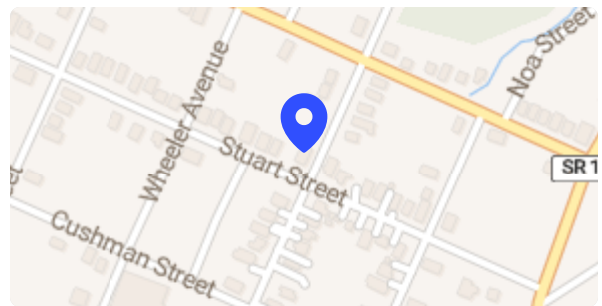

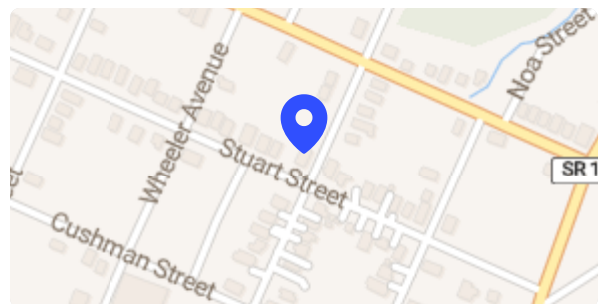

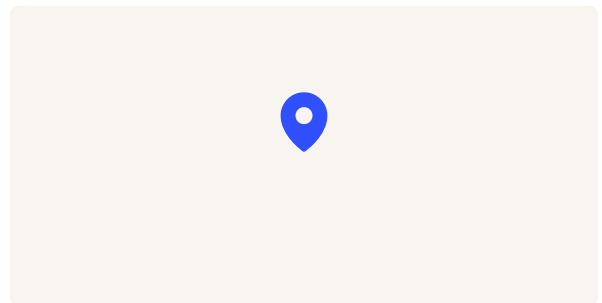
