Waymon “WO” Oliver, 82, of Chattanooga, recently succumbed to his earthly life on Friday, May 26, 2023, in the Hospice Care at The Waters of Winchester Nursing Facility. He was our beloved Father, Brother, Uncle, Cousin, and Friend. Waymon was born March 24, 1941 in Chattanooga, Tennessee. He was the youngest of two sons born to Lewis Bibbs and Lois Oliver. 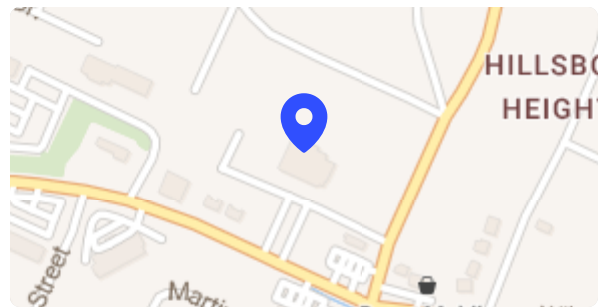

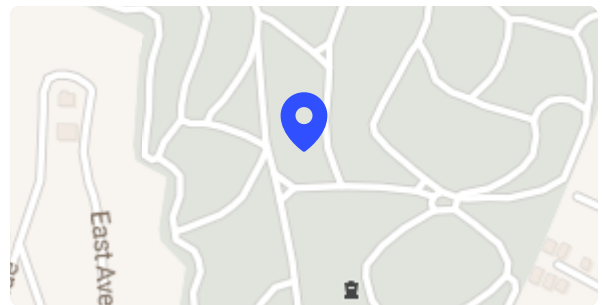
