Kenneth Edward Moore, 70, formerly of Chattanooga, passed away Sunday, September 3, 2023, at his Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia residence. He was born on September 9, 1952, in Chattanooga, Tennessee. Kenneth was educated in the Chattanooga School System and graduated from Chattanooga (City) High in 1970. He also attended Alabama A&M University and Chattanooga State Community College. He was affectionately known as “Kenny”. Kenny started work at an early age, first at Leaders in downtown Chattanooga, where he was promoted to a retail buyer at the age of 19. Then he worked at Dupont Company before landing his passion and forever career in the mental health field. He worked over 50 years between Moccasin Bend Mental Health, Joe Johnson Mental Health, and Parkridge Valley Mental Health ultimately retiring from Moccasin Bend in 2017. 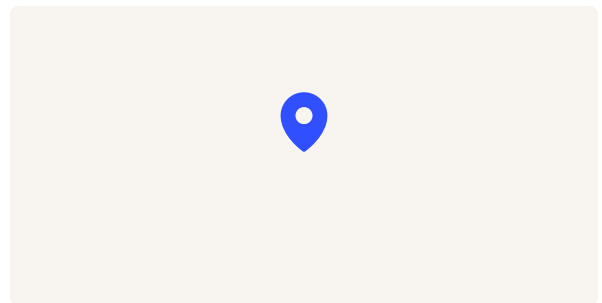

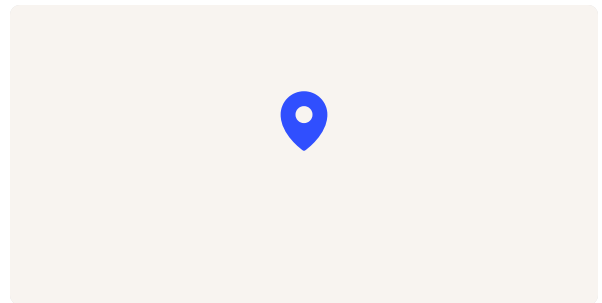
