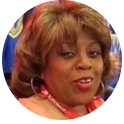

Brenda Lene Mitchell, 74, of Oakland, California, passed away Saturday, January 6, 2024 in a nursing facility in Haywood, California. She had been hospitalized for well over a year because of complications of many strokes. She was born in Toney, Alabama and raised in Chattanooga, Tennessee. She accepted Christ at an early age. Brenda, graduated from Howard High School, class of 1967, where she was a member of the fabulous marching 100's band. Brenda's classmates loved her funny personality, so in her senior year, she was selected class 'most wittiest'. She was also active in extracurricular activities and participated in the high school production in 196, titled, "The Bad Seed". After graduation, Brenda joined the US Army, where she served 3 years and was honorably discharged. 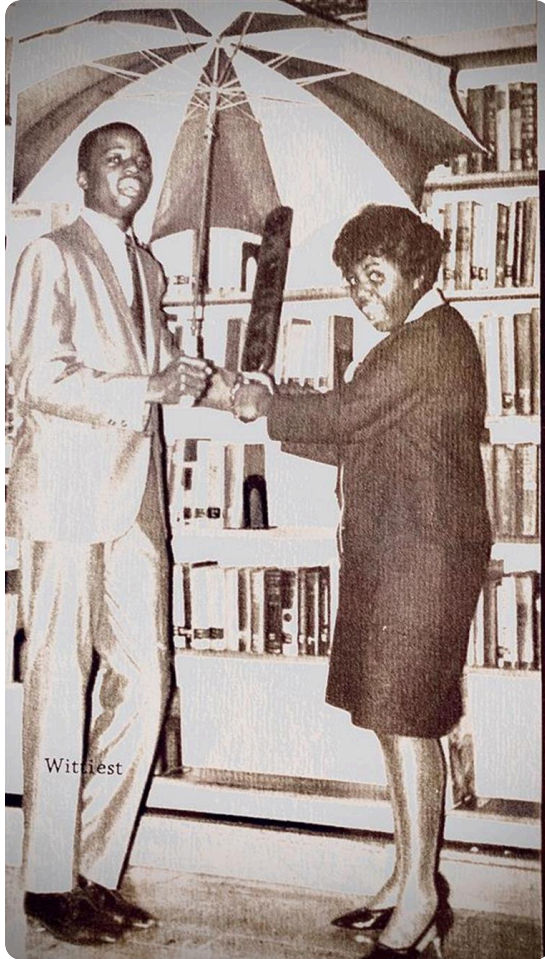
