**G**eraldine “Jerry” Jones Hope, 91, of Chattanooga, transitioned peacefully on Friday, August 2, 2024, in a local hospital. A cherished mother, grandmother, great and great-great grandmother, she was born on July 9, 1933, in Birmingham, Alabama. Geraldine was the beloved daughter of Alberta Richmond Jones and Jesse Jerry Jones. Known affectionately as “Moma” and “T Jerry” by her family, Geraldine was a force that impacted the lives of everyone around her. A proud graduate of Dunbar High School in Birmingham, Geraldine began a life dedicated to family and service. She first married Charlie Edd Townsend, with whom she had two beloved children, Franchester and Doug Townsend. In 1963, she married the love of her life, Thomas Hope, with whom she shared a deeply fulfilling partnership until his untimely passing in 1986. Geraldine discovered her true calling in caregiving, earning her certification as a Geriatric Nursing Aide in 1964. 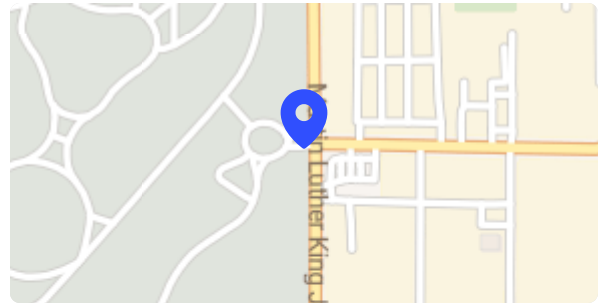

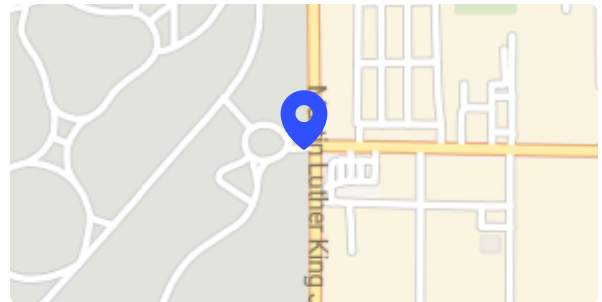
