Mary Magdalene Clark, 72, of Chattanooga, passed away on Saturday, August 31, 2024, at her residence. She was preceded in death by her parents, Felton Julius Clark, Sr. and Ocea Lee Clark; her daughter, Shaneka LaShun Storey; her brothers, David Stanley Clark, Roy Lee Clark, Napoleon Bonaparte Clark, Sr., and Felton Julius Clark, Jr.; and her sister, Rosa Mae Ryan. Mary was born on July 30, 1952, in Chattanooga, Tennessee. She grew up in Dewberry, Georgia, and eventually settled back in Chattanooga.
