Reverend Anthony Warren Chatman

OCT 17, 1958 - DEC 28, 2024

Reverend Anthony Warren Chatman, 66, of Chattanooga, transitioned peacefully at his home, surrounded by loved ones, on December 28, 2024. His life was a testament to the power of faith, the importance of justice, and the beauty of a life lived with purpose.

Born on October 17, 1958, in Rockwood, Tennessee, Anthony's spiritual foundation was laid early at Speight Chapel AME Zion Church, his original church home in Rockwood, TN. This faith carried him through a remarkable life of ministry and service, which included roles as Associate Minister and Sunday School teacher at Monumental Baptist Church, Former Associate Minister at Wesley Chapel Christian Community Church, Former Pastor of Fields Chapel AME Zion, and Athletic Director of River of Life Church. With his Master of Ministry Degree and a heart devoted to God, Anthony's ministry touched countless lives, embodying the belief that "to serve others is to serve God."

Anthony was also an advocate for justice and equality. As the first Vice President of the State of Tennessee NAACP, he championed civil rights and uplifted underserved communities. His service as a United States Marine Corps Staff Sergeant and a police officer in Chattanooga reflected his steadfast commitment to discipline and honor, whether serving his community or country.

Anthony was a man of many talents and passions. A black-belt martial artist, skilled chess player, championship football player, and avid outdoorsman, he found joy in fishing, motorcycle riding, and golf. He shined as a signed actor, model, and coach, showcasing leadership and resilience in every role.

One of his proudest accomplishments was being a member of the first line of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Inc., Chi Lambda chapter "The unknown 8", at Tennessee Tech University, a testament to his dedication to brotherhood, scholarship, and service.

I am extending my sympathy to the family of Reverend Anthony Chatman. I had the privilege of meeting Rev. Chatman and his late wife in 2004, after the death of my son Leslie. On January 2, 2004, unarmed Leslie was killed by 4 Chattanooga police officers by positional asphyxia, in the same manner as George Floyd in later years. Anthony Chatman was one of the persons who came to our aid, even though he did not know us personally. At that time, our family had already moved away from Chattanooga. He extended sympathy and compassion to us. He was a Christian man who lived his faith, and believed in helping his fellow man. He was a comfort to our family and believed that Leslie's homicide was the result of unnecessary excessive force. In fact, because he believed in serving, protecting and helping people, he had earlier joined the police force. He told us that he resigned from the department, because he observed actions of some fellow officers, that were inconsistent with his beliefs. He truly believed in justice for all. I feel that his love ones, and others who knew him well, have received God's blessing through their relationship with him. Anthony Chatman left a legacy of love and service. He will be missed.
