Sylvester Taylor, 72, of Chattanooga, passed away May 2, 2025, at his residence. He was born March 10, 1953, in Chattanooga, Tennessee to the late Fred and Helen Taylor. He was the youngest of 7 children. Sylvester was a 1972 graduate of Riverside High School in Chattanooga, Tennessee.

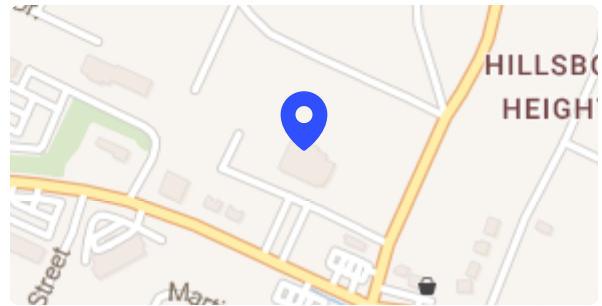

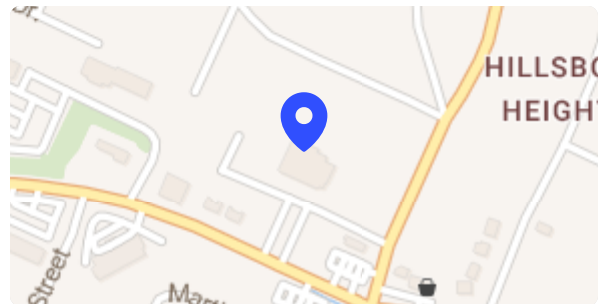

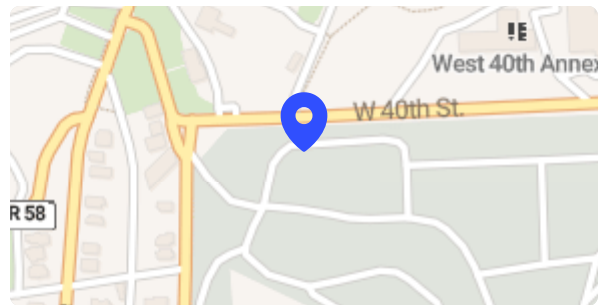
