Denise Thurman, 62, affectionately known as ‘Niecey’, started her earthly journey on November 10, 1963, in Chattanooga, Tennessee, born to Ocie Thurman and James Taylor. She entered eternal rest on Wednesday, November 19, 2025, surrounded by her loving family in the comfort of her home. Niecey went to the one that loved her the most leaving a void in the hearts of her family that will never be filled.

She was educated in the Chattanooga public school system. She graduated from Chattanooga Adult High School in 1981.

Niecey accepted Christ at an early age under the pastorage of Rev. Wilmer Russ at Zion Hill Missionary Baptist Church. There, she sang in the junior choir. Later, under the pastorage of Rev. Calton Douglas, she sang in the choir, was a youth director, and was superintendent of Sunday school for a number of years.
